

Executives head for African Utility Week

ABOUT 37 utility chief executives from South Africa and across the African continent, including Eskom's Phakamani Hadebe, are expected to attend African Utility Week and Powergen Africa in Cape Town next week.

According to the organisers of the event, the chief executives will participate in the co-located Utility CEO Forum 2019, which is a closed boardroom meeting.

They will, however, also participate in joint activities and sessions.

Jeff Radebe, Minister of Energy, is expected to deliver the opening keynote address at the conference.

The 19th edition of African Utility Week and Powergen Africa will take place at the Cape Town International Convention Centre from Tuesday to Thursday.

It's billed as the continent's leading sector conference and exhibition, and the organisers say it is expected to attract more than 10000 senior level executives, 300 speakers, 350 exhibitors, and 77 utilities and municipalities.
