AFRICAN UTILITY WEEK MAY 14-16

ABOUT 35 utility chief executives from the African continent, including Eskom chief executive Phakamani Hadebe, are expected to attend African Utility Week and Powergen Africa in Cape Town this month. According to the organisers of the event, the chief executives will participate in the co-located Utility CEO Forum 2019, which is a closed boardroom meeting. Chief executives will, however, also participate in joint activities and sessions with African Utility Week and Powergen Africa. The 19th edition of African Utility Week and Powergen Africa at the Cape Town International Convention Centre from May 14 to 16 is the continent's leading sector conference and exhibition, which is also expected to attract more than 10 000 senior level executives, 300 renowned speakers, 350 exhibitors and 77 utilities and municipalities.
